Workshop objectives

The course aims to familiarize the practicing orthodontist with the following:

- What is evidence-based orthodontics and how can be applied by the clinician in her/his everyday clinical practice?
- How to search and select scientific articles from the orthodontic literature in order to inform clinical practice?
- How to assess the validity and quality of clinical studies in orthodontics?
- Highlight orthodontic interventions supported and not supported by the existing scientific evidence.

Summary

- Introduction: Why do I need evidence-based orthodontics in my practice and how can I implement it?
- Searching and selecting the best available evidence with practical exercises.
- Evaluation of clinical studies in orthodontics.
- How to read and interpret a systematic review?
- Review of the scientific evidence on selected orthodontic topics.
- Practical assessment of a published clinical study. This part will be interactive. The participants will read and critically assess a published article from the orthodontic literature.

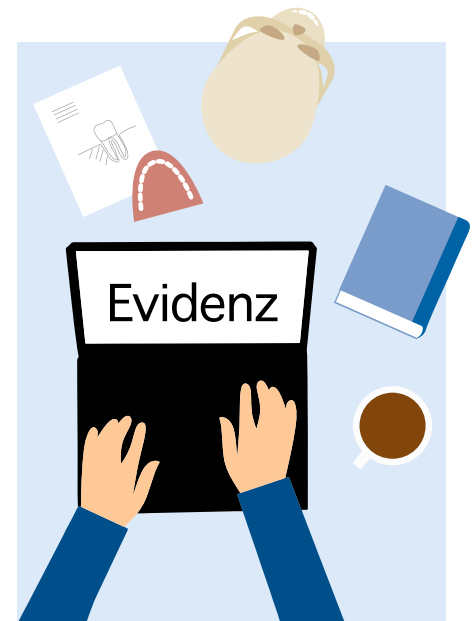
