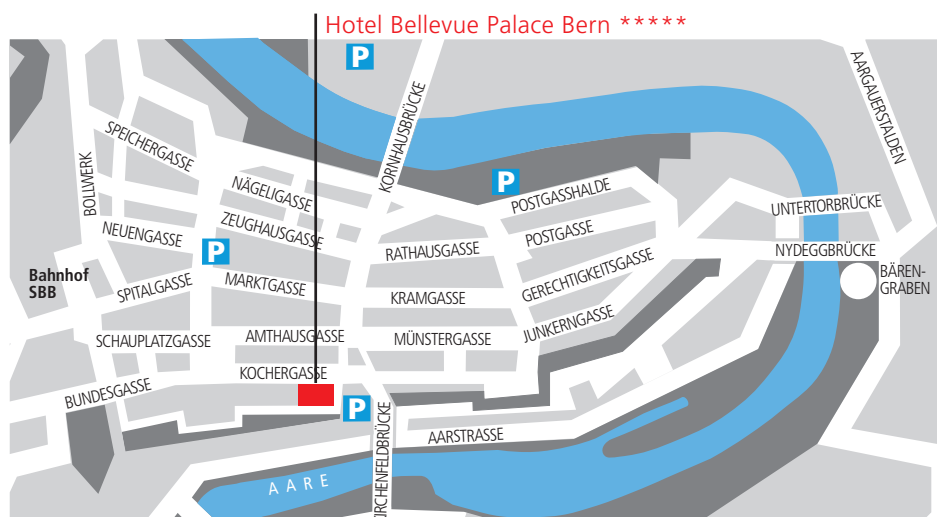

Prof. Dr. Lars Bondemark



Professor Bondemark is Professor Emeritus in Orthodontics at the Faculty of Odontology, Malmö University, Sweden, where he served as the Dean of the Faculty of Odontology between 2009 and 2012.

Professor Bondemark has co-authored more than 90 scientific articles and textbook chapters, including more than 30 RCTs and systematic reviews. He has also co-authored the textbook «Essential Orthodontics». His research is focused on the assessment and validation of evidence based practices in orthodontics and covers orthodontic treatment, retention, patients perceptions, quality of life, cost-effectiveness, nocturnal treatment for snoring and sleep apnea. Another area of interest pertains to the consequences of premature birth on the prevalence of malocclusion, treatment needs and craniofacial morphology. Professor Bondemark has supervised 13 students towards their doctoral thesis (Odont Dr/PhD). He is a reviewer for numerous journals and also member of the Editorial Board of European Journal of Orthodontics and Orthodontics and Craniofacial Research.

He has given over 70 lectures nationally and internationally and in 2012, he was the recipient of the Beni Solow Award for the best paper published in the European Journal of Orthodontics. He received the Most Outstanding Oral Presentation Award during the 2nd International Conference on Evidence-based Advanced Dentistry in Hong Kong, China, in 2007. In 2000, Professor Bondemark received the Student's Educational Award for the most outstanding teacher at Malmö University. He is also a co-author of the most-cited article «Five-year post retention outcomes of three retention methods – a randomized controlled trial» published in 2017 in the European Journal of Orthodontics. In 2016, Professor Bondemark served as the Chair of the Scientific Committee of the European Orthodontic Society for the EOS-Congress in Stockholm. He is a member of the Angle Society of Europe.

Prof. Dr. Stavros Kiliaridis



Professor Kiliaridis has been Professor and Chairman of the Department of Orthodontics, University of Geneva, since 1999. During the academic period 2008–2009 he served as Professor at the University of Athens, Greece. Since 2020 he is adjunct Professor at the University of Bern.

His research is focused on masticatory muscle influence on dentofacial growth, post-emergent phases of tooth eruption, diagnostic methods of oral function, dentofacial aberrations in individuals with neuromuscular diseases, outcome of different orthodontic interventions and side effects linked to orthodontic treatment. He has supervised 14 PhD students at the Universities of Göteborg, Nijmegen and Geneva, 12 Doctorate students towards their doctoral thesis (Dr Med Dent), and 16 Master students to obtain their Master in Orthodontics. He received major research grants from the Swedish Medical Research Council for 12 years and from the Swiss National Science Foundation for 21 years, 3 times as principal investigator or 6 times as co-applicant.

Professor Kiliaridis has authored or co-authored over 230 research papers and several book-chapters, and is reviewer for many international scientific journals. He has been a speaker at numerous orthodontic congresses and lectured at many universities worldwide. He was coordinator (2006–2015) of the European Orthodontic Teachers Forum, and president (2017–2019) of the Network for Erasmus Based European Orthodontic Programmes (NEBEOP). He was recipient of the European Orthodontic Society Essay Award 1988 and was honoured as Alton Moore Annual Memorial Lecturer, University of Washington in 2002. Moreover, Professor Kiliaridis received the Sheldon Friel Memorial Lecture 2015, which is the highest award given by the European Orthodontic Society. The scientific work performed by his students under his supervision has been internationally awarded on numerous occasions. He is a member of the Angle Society of Europe.
