

Prof. Dr. Stavros Kiliaridis



Professor Stavros Kiliaridis graduated from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece in 1979. In 1984 he completed his specialist education in Orthodontics at the University of Göteborg, Sweden, where he also received his PhD in 1986 and served as Associate Professor from 1991 until 1999. From 1999 until 2021 he served as Professor and Director of the Department of Orthodontics, University of Geneva, while in the academic period 2008-9 he was appointed Professor and Chairman of Orthodontics at the University of Athens, Greece. Since 2020 he is Adjunct

Professor at the University of Bern and in 2021 he was nominated Professor Emeritus at the University of Geneva. His research is focused on the influence of the masticatory muscle on dentofacial growth, tooth eruption, diagnostic methods of oral function, dentofacial aberrations in individuals with neuromuscular diseases, outcome of different orthodontic interventions and side effects linked to orthodontic treatment. He has supervised 14 PhD students at the Universities of Göteborg, Nijmegen and Geneva, 12 Doctorate students (Dr. med. dent.), and 18 Master in orthodontics students. Over his career he was the recipient of twelve major research grants from the Swedish Medical Research Council and nine from the Swiss National Science Foundation.

Professor Kiliaridis has authored or co-authored over 230 research papers and several book chapters and is a reviewer for many international scientific journals. He has been an invited speaker at numerous orthodontic congresses and has lectured worldwide. He coordinated the European Orthodontic Teachers Forum (2006–2015), and presided (2017–2019) the Network for Erasmus Based European Orthodontic Programmes (NEBEOP). He was the recipient of the European Orthodontic Society Essay Award 1988 and was named the Alton Moore Annual Memorial Lecturer, University of Washington in 2002. Moreover, Professor Kiliaridis received the Sheldon Friel Memorial Lecture in 2015 and the Distinguished Teacher Award 2022 from the European Orthodontic Society. The scientific work performed by his students under his supervision has been recognized internationally on numerous occasions. He is member of the Angle Society of Europe.

Prof. Dr. Timo Peltomäki



Professor Timo Peltomäki graduated from the University of Turku, Finland in 1982 and completed his orthodontic education at the Institute of Dentistry, University of Turku in 1988, and PhD in 1993. In 2002, he became docent in oral development and orthodontics.

Over the years he held posts at the Institute of Dentistry, University of Turku (1984–2005), and he worked as orthodontic practitioner in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia (1993–1996) and as research fellow at the Institute of Reconstructive Plastic Surgery, New York University Medical Center, USA

(1999–2000). In 2005 he was appointed professor and head of Clinic for Orthodontics and Paediatric Dentistry, Centre for Dental and Oral Medicine, University of Zurich, Switzerland and in September 2009, he returned to Finland to become head of the orthodontic department at Tampere University Hospital. In 2014 he was appointed professor of dentistry at the Faculty of Medicine and Health Technology, Tampere University, Finland, and in 2017 professor of orthodontics at the Faculty Health Sciences, University of Easter Finland.

Dr Peltomäki held numerous academic administrative positions: Research Council member for Biosciences, Health and Environment, Academy of Finland (2019–2021), council member of the Finnish Dental Society Apollonia (2013–2018, 2022–), European Orthodontic Society (2011–2016) and euroTMjoint network on TMJ in juvenile idiopathic arthritis (2014–2017). He was associate editor of the European Journal of Orthodontics (2010–2018). Professor Peltomäki's main research interests lie in craniofacial growth and development, sleep apnea, orthognathic treatment and juvenile idiopathic arthritis. He has more than 120 publications and has lectured widely at national and international meetings. He was given the Distinguished Teacher Award by the European Orthodontic Society in 2019, and the Charles Bolender Award 2019 by the European Federation of Orthodontic Specialist Association.
